



Thousands received homeopathic service during Kumbh

The first Kumbh Mela of this century was celebrated in an overflowing enthusiasm and amidst unprecedented security in Nashik and at holy town Trimbakeshwar in Maharashtra. During this period the homeopathy medical camp was organised for the first time by Dr. Amarsinha Nikam and his team. This free camp was arranged in Gagangiri Maharaj's Santnagari here from August 12 to September 7 for the pilgrims from different parts of the country.

Dr. Nikam runs a homeopathic hospital of its own unique kind - Aditya Homeopathic Hospital and Healing Centre - at Pimpri, Pune.

Two thousand sadhus, saints, mahants and devotees took advantage of this opportunity, the release said.

Blood pressure, kidney related diseases, diabetes, heart problems, asthma, cancer, rheumatism, lung related diseases and such other incurable diseases were treated in this camp.

Under the able guidance and competence of Dr. Nikam, a team of fifty homeopathy doctors from Pune, Satara, Solapur, Nagar, Ratnagiri, Kolhapur, Jalgaon, Mumbai and Goa apart from Nashik participated in this camp.

While talking to mediapersons, Dr. Nikam explained that the motives behind organising such a camp was to propagate the homeopathic treatment among people, to provide self-confidence among the practising doctors and to achieve a meagre share of Kumbh Mela.

There are numerous homeopathic clinics in India, however Dr. Nikam is cred-



ited to have started the first homeopathic hospital in India where we don't find injections, salines and oxygen cylinders.

It is worth mentioning that Dr. Nikam's book entitled *Homeopathy: The Art of Rapid and Gentle Healing* is being published dur-

ing this month. Dr. Nikam is a visiting professor in homeopathy in Bharati Vidyapeeth, Pune.

Dr. Nikam's family members and his numerous friends along with a team of 50 specialist doctors extended hands of co-opera-

tion for the success of this camp. Jyotiram Kadam, Mane, Dadage and Shukla provided special assistance for the success of the camp. Dr. Nikam also availed of his ambulance for emergency medical services during the Kumbh event.
